Sub: Obtaining Proof of Relationship during enrolment of children and roll out of Child Enrolment Client

- Ref: 1 O M No. 4(4)/57/159/2014-E&U-Pt. dated 16.04.2015 regarding enrolment of children of age below 5 years
 - O M No. 4(4)/57/159/2014-E&U-Pt. dated 22.04.2015 regarding change in process/procedure for enrolment of child below age 5 years using child enrolment client light (CEL)

Reference is invited to above mentioned OMs through which the guidelines in respect of child enrolment light client (CELC) were circulated.

- 2. With a view to avoid any possible fraudulent enrolment and on the basis of feedback received from the ecosystem partners, it has been decided to continue the requirement of taking PoR in the CELC(phase –I) as in case of ECMP. The CELC (phase-I) is proposed to be rolled out in the week of 15th June 2015. (Exact date will be communicated separately.) In the CELC (phase-II), which would be released after 8 weeks of release of CELC (phase-I), the PoR document will be scanned and uploaded as part of the packet itself.
- 3. It is further brought out that the CELC deployment Plan of EAs, which would be mainly operated in Anganwadi Centres, would be got approved from the concerned ROs by the Registrars. All the ROs may kindly ensure readiness for the rollout, including conducting of training and certification of operators.
- 4. In view of PoR requirement as above, the child enrolment policy and the document collection process for CELC would be revised and circulated separately.

5. This issues with the approval of DG & MD, UIDAI.
